

The Peer Support and Advocacy role is a holistic community based kaupapa Māori service for tamariki and rangatahi up to 18 years old and their whānau. This service is free and available to anyone.

Is: Our service area is Waihi Beach through to Whakamaramara. advocate role is a non-clinical service which provides support, education, and and rangatahi who have, or may be experiencing problems. These problems hānau based or environmental and they may lead to behavioural problems at community. The service is youth lead and focused, it takes place anywhere the tamaiti and their whānau feel most comfortable.


